- Develop skills for implementing risk mitigation strategies and maintaining a safe clinical environment.

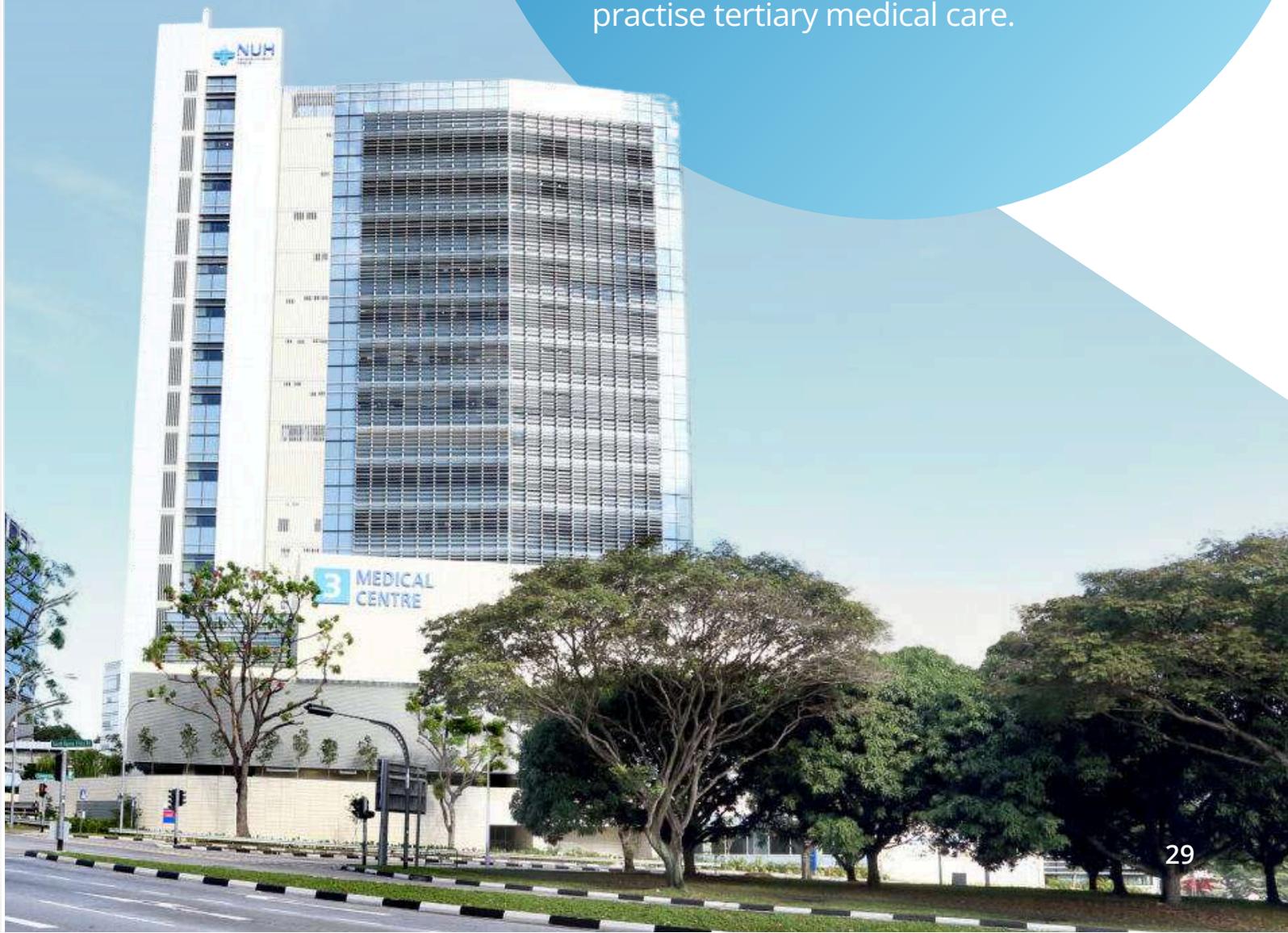




ABOUT NATIONAL UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL

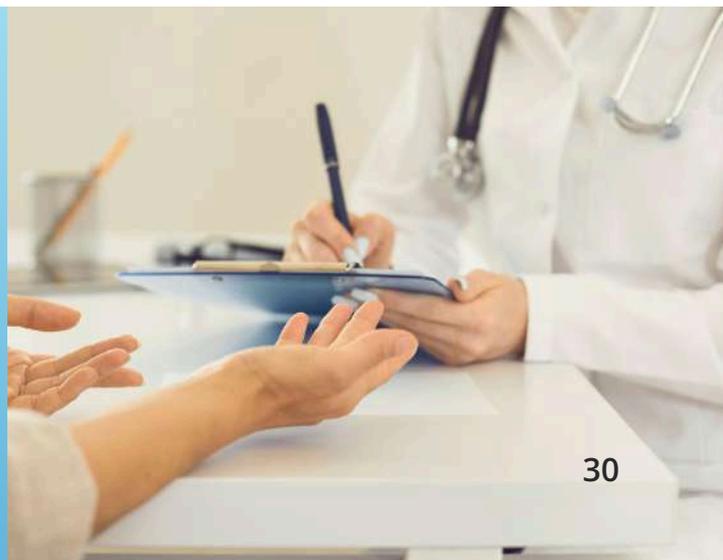
We offer an environment where research and teaching are an integral part of medicine and continue to shape medicine and transform care for the community we care for.
